Promising Practices used in New Britain/Wheeler LAUNCH activities:

Activities	Description
Child First	Evidence-based home visiting program serving children birth-6 years presenting with social, emotional, behavioral concerns.
Circle of Security Parenting	Promising evidence attachment-based parenting program that can be used in group or in-home settings with parents of young children
HALO	Healthy Alternatives for Little Ones-Evidence-based health education and substance abuse prevention program for preschoolers.
FLIP-It	Promising practice strategy to support early care and education providers with managing challenging behaviors (Feelings, Limits, Inquiries, Prompts)
Second Step	Evidence-based violence prevention program for children in preschool through third grade.

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ASQ/ASQ:SE	Validated child development screening protocol (ASQ-screens five developmental domains, ASQ:SE-screens only social-emotional development)
Strengthening Families Framework	A research-informed approach to increase family strengths, enhance child development and reduce the likelihood of child abuse and neglect.
EPIC	Educating Practices in the Community: a comprehensive, community-based, child health provider outreach and training program.
